Discussion will include Lyme Awareness in BC, prevention, proper tick removal technique, symptoms, treatment and more! Public Q & A will follow.

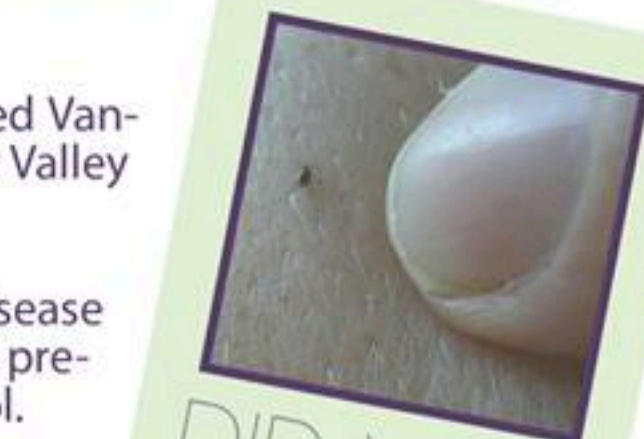
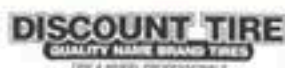
